The season of celebration culminates with Christmas eve worship services at 3:30pm, 5:30 pm, and 11pm, and Christmas Day worship at 8:30 am. Come, bring your friends and family, and share in the celebration of the giving of the gift of God – for you!

In this season of preparation for the giving of the gift, we're also continuing our tradition of giving to our community. In the season of Advent, we'll be responding to God's amazing gift to us by giving our gifts back to God – every weekend worship service during Advent you'll see a 'giving tree' at the front of the sanctuary. This tree is adorned with ornaments that look like gift tags, and each gift tag represents a child or a family in our community who need Jesus to reach out to them this year by getting a gift from Trinity Lutheran Church, supplied by people like you and me. As you prepare for Christmas, pray about what God would have you give to the work of His Kingdom through Trinity Lutheran Church, then bring your gifts and place them under the tree as you come to worship during Advent – It's our giving of the gift in the season of God giving us the gift of Jesus – what a great way to worship our God!

As we bring 2016 to a close, may we be a church that is gripped by God's grace and love, gathered around a manger with Mary and Joseph and all the animals to receive God's love born as a baby. Welcome to our world, Jesus!


#### **GIVING TREE**


#### FREE FINANCIAL COACHING
