A Message From Your Council President...

Hello Trinity Family,

I hope everyone had a great Christmas! It sure is nice during the holidays to see families together at church. We get to see the family members that maybe moved to another city, or state. Maybe you get to talk with an old classmate you haven't seen since last year, or a confirmation classmate, and you talk about the "old days". Maybe you just sit in church and watch how the families have grown up and now bring in their children and grandchildren. It's a wonderful time of the year!

Trinity Lutheran Church goes back a long time. Over 125 years. What do you think it was like for those first families? Getting a new church started; starting up a Sunday School; finding a Pastor; putting down a foundation for a new Lutheran church. Kind of sounds like us right now, doesn't it? There are cycles that happen in almost everything. Trinity is now in the part of the cycle where we have a core membership, but not a huge congregation. But that is changing. I have noticed some new people at our services the last few weeks. Some may want to join Trinity, and some may be checking out many churches to see which one fits their family. I hope we can help them find the right church for their family.

We used to go outside our walls to do outreach for the community. But now our community comes inside the walls of Trinity. Some years ago we started a neighborhood block party, now it is a full blown community gathering for all of our neighbors and community members. A small Children's clothes closet has become a destination for families with children and teenagers. A couple of churches serving a free meal to neighbors has become about 10 churches alternating to volunteer serving over 120 people each Monday. And a food pantry that has become so vibrant that they need to use our whole stage downstairs to serve our neighbors in need of some food. And the County of La Crosse came to us and asked if they could have social workers in our building to be near some of the people they serve.

Wow!!!! The amount of outreach we do for our neighborhood has turned into outreach for our community. Yes, we get help from other churches, businesses, individuals, non-Lutherans, and non-Christians. But that just proves that we are continuing a solid foundation for the future of Trinity. Be proud! We are doing a great job of making sure the foundation started over 125 years ago stays solid. For our own congregation and our families. For the future families with or without children, and those that do not attend our services. They still come for our outreach, and that is what we are about. Treating everyone the same as Jesus would treat everyone.

Their area really looks like a boutique and makes a great place for young women to "shop". These ladies are very excited about the success they have had here. They report that in Onalaska, they served about 10-12 women a month, but here are serving that same number each week. Much thanks and praise for all their work to serve the young women in our community.
