"The joy of the Lord is your strength." Nehemiah 8:10

This verse has been a favorite of mine for a long time, mostly because I have found it to be true. Finding joy in God *and* trusting that God can and does find joy in me both give me great strength. When these words were first spoken by leadership to the Israelites, the community had been living lives far from God. Their time of worship began with the reading of the Law of Moses. Upon hearing the words of truth in the Law spoken, they began to weep aloud for how far they had strayed from God's desire for their lives. But Ezra and Nehemiah and other leaders among them said that this time of truth-telling is intended to be life-giving. We are to find joy in the Lord when the Law is revealed, and this joy will become our strength.

Too often our reaction to missing the mark is one of despair, especially if we seem to be tripping up over and over again. And yet, we can also see these times of faltering as new beginnings. God's Law certainly shows us how we have fallen short, but its true role for us is one of loving guidance. Throughout the Law, one thing remains clear: God's love for us. As we face places in our lives that require repentance and repair, may we lean into the joy of a God who loves us. That leaning shall become our strength.



A victim of modern slavery or human trafficking is anyone who is coerced or deceived into doing labor or services against their will. This Task Force is made up of more than 50 persons from the La Crosse area including FSPA and affiliates, law enforcement, education, legal, social service and health care professionals. They are working together to raise awareness about the incidence and response to victims in the La Crosse, Wisconsin area.
